LAURA THORNE

My approach to painting and materials has shifted over the last five years. It's become more intimate as I study plants and birds in our tiny backyard urban sanctuary and other nearby refuges. A few years ago, we remodeled our house to bring my studio home without disturbing the garden. Now, instead of rushing through the city to get to work, I take a walk through the neighborhood. Returning to the garden, I sit between the arbutus and the serviceberry and watch what happens in the habitat we've cultivated for over 25 years. A delicate, interdependent complexity emerges between us, as I notice that my presence is felt by the flora and fauna and I attune to their aliveness within me.

I use oil sticks whose edges mutate, blend, break apart, coalesce, weave and interpenetrate in gestural bands of color. With painting, unfettered from concepts, I'm free to explore what it feels like to be conscious of outer and inner landscapes and to express these as embodied rhythms. My shapes may be seen as organic forms or read as abstract geometric repetition, or both. Using patterns in a soft grid, I see/feel into and through the work, bypassing words, reaching for unfamiliar and unexpected liaisons as the process asserts an imperative to mutiny. My strategies are often eclipsed by the painting as it dives towards mystery and makes a new kind of sense of the world.
