This exhibition is the first complete reconsideration of these galleries since the SAM Downtown expansion in 2007 and brings together exceptional loans and stunning treasures from SAM's collection.

The works in this stunning exhibition are all from the private collection of the 1st Earl of Iveagh, Edward Cecil Guinness (1847–1927), heir to the Guinness brewing fortune. The collection is usually on view at Kenwood House in London, but this year 48 of the greatest works from the Iveagh Bequest are coming to SAM.
